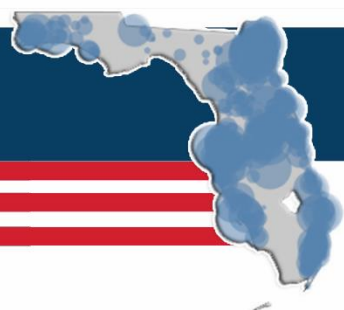

## **Family Support Programs in 2020**

### **Back-to-School Brigade**

- 1,538 backpacks filled with school supplies provided to military children at 10 BTSB events across the state.

### **Holiday Meals for Military**

- 414 military families served at 6 HMFM events across the state.

### **Permanent Homes for Veterans**

- PHV has provided 122 mortgage-free homes in Florida; 107 homes deeded to families, 14 families currently enrolled, and 1 home on the way.

### **Transitional Homes for Veterans**

- 4 homes currently occupied, and 1 home pending move in, giving service members an opportunity to successfully transition to civilian life.

### **Veteran Caregiver Support**

- 6 VCS groups with 432 members, providing ongoing support and camaraderie to the caregivers of wounded, ill, and injured

### **Morale Events**

- Bluewater Movement's annual Operation Sailfish provided 25 veterans the opportunity to enjoy a complimentary day on the water during "Take a Hero Fishing Day".

In 2020, Operation Homefront's Critical Financial Assistance program provided \$261,105.72 to military families in Florida to help with rent, utilities, food, and home and auto repairs.

Since 2011, Operation Homefront has provided \$2,671,436.12 in financial assistance to America's military heroes statewide.
